Summary

In the paper, the 26th international conference of Jonas Jablonskis LINGUISTIC DIVERSITY IN THE MODERN WORLD: LANGUAGE POWER AND PRESTIGE is presented. The conference was held on October 3–4, 2019 at the Institute of the Lithuanian Language, Lithuania.
