**ILL RESEARCH JOURNALS EDITORS-IN-CHIEF APPOINTMENT,
EDITORIAL BOARDS APPOINTMENT AND CHANGE
PROCEDURE**

I. APPOINTMENT OF EDITOR-IN-CHIEF

1. The candidacy of the editor-in-chief is submitted to the ILL Scientific Council (hereinafter, the Scientific Council) by a directorate or a group of researchers. At the meeting of the Scientific Council, the candidate presents the concept of the research journal. The editor-in-chief is elected by the Scientific Council by secret ballot.

2. The editor-in-chief is remunerated for his work on the basis of the description of the procedure for planning and evaluating the work of ILL researchers.

II. EDITORIAL BOARD COMPOSITION

3. The Editorial Board is appointed by the editor-in-chief and approved by the Scientific Council.

4. New members of the Editorial Board shall be appointed or replaced by mutual agreement between the editor-in-chief and the members of the Editorial Board, and the Scientific Council shall be informed thereof.

5. Upon the dismissal of the editor-in-chief, the editorial board shall also resign.

III. EDITOR-IN-CHIEF DISMISSAL

6. The editor-in-chief shall be dismissed by the Scientific Council:

- 6.1. at the request of the editor-in-chief,
 - 6.2. on a proposal from the Editorial Board,
 - 6.3. on a proposal from the Directorate.
